## **Existing View**

This viewpoint is representative of motorists using the rural lane on Lon Leidr to the south of Llandyfrydog to the east of Maen Hir South 'A' and north of Maen Hir South 'B'. To the left, the view comprises the rural lane and mature hedgerows. From the centre left to the centre right of the view, geometric and undulating pastoral fields can be seen beyond the intervening hedgerow. The elevated landform at Pen y Foel can be seen to the centre right, with Llwydiarth Tower on the summit. To the right of the view, geometric pastoral fields sit within a more level landform, which can be seen at an oblique angle above the hedgerow which borders the rural lane. The view is generally characterised by a gently rolling topography with relatively high treecover.

## **Operation Phase**

Maen Hir South 'A' and Maen Hir South 'B' would be partially visible to varying degrees in the midground view beyond intervening hedgerows. To the left, the majority of views towards Maen Hir South 'B' are screened by intervening vegetation and landform. To the centre left of the view, parts of the north-western area of Maen Hir South 'B' can be seen above the hedgerow with Field 173 visible near Cwyrt Farm. To the centre right, Field 172 can be seen on rising land. Further right, Maen Hir South 'A' can be seen with Field 171 (mitigation and enhancement area) located on the summit of Pen y Foel. Fields 165 and 153 are partially visible in the midground view beyond intervening hedgerows. To the right of the view, there may be glimpsed views of Field 145 which is a potential location for a 132kV Substation, whilst fields to the north-east of Maen Hir South 'A' can be seen above the hedgerow at an oblique angle within Fields 135 and 140. During the operation phase, the scale of effects are likely to be **Medium** (adverse) reducing to **Small** (adverse) once the embedded mitigation has established.
