Representative Viewpoint 22 (Left) - Public footpath LLANNERCH-Y-MEDD|25/012/1 on higher ground near Bachau to east of Llannerch-y-medd

Existing View

This view is representative of walkers using public footpath 25/012/1 where it connects the B5111 with Bachau to the north approximately 0.6km to the west of Maen Hir South 'B'. The viewpoint is semi-elevated and offers long-distance views to the east across Maen Hir South 'B' towards Capel Coch. To the left, the view is obscured by a hedgerow in the foreground, whilst the centre and right of the view comprises a large pastoral field which stretches to the midground. Beyond the midground, the centre of the view contains an area of marshy grassland with geometric pastoral fields bordered by small-to-medium hedgerows. The village of Capel Coch can be seen towards the centre and rear of the midground view. The midground of the right view comprises a mature hedgerow which borders the neighbouring field and foreshortens views beyond, although the B5111 and associated properties are perceptible. Towards the background of the centre and right of the view, there are several small blocks of woodland and treebelts ahead of the Snowdonia mountain range within Eryri National Park in the far distance.

Operation Phase

Maen Hir South 'B' would be partially visible with lower lying areas from this viewpoint. Elevated sections of the north western area of Maen Hir South 'B' would be partially visible towards the centre of the view with Fields 181 and 186 particularly visible. Sections of the north-eastern area of Maen Hir South 'B' are visible beyond. To the right of the view, Fields 226 and 232 are visible on the higher ground and there may be views of the potential 132kV Substations. Further right, views of the southern area of Maen Hir South 'B' would be predominantly screened by intervening topography and hedgerows. During the operation phase, the scale of effects are likely to be **Medium** (adverse) reducing to **Small** (adverse) once the embedded mitigation has established.
