Lightsource bp invites you to take part in the public consultation on our proposals for Prosiect Maen Hir

Prosiect Maen Hir is a solar and energy storage project we're proposing in the northeast of the Isle of Anglesey.

Our proposed project has the potential to generate 360 megawatts (MW) of electricity through ground-mounted solar panels – enough clean energy to power around 140,000 homes and avoid more than 71,000 tonnes of $\rm CO_2$ every year.

It would comprise the installation of solar photovoltaic (PV) panels and an on-site energy storage facility, plus infrastructure to connect the project to the national grid so that the electricity it generates can be made available to homes and businesses. Incorporated within our proposals is a community solar project which would generate funds that could be used to support and deliver local projects and initiatives to benefit local communities closest to the development.

Subject to being consented, Prosiect Maen Hir would support the Anglesey Energy Island[™] Programme, delivering affordable, clean electricity to help achieve Welsh Government Net Zero targets, while providing energy security of supply and value to us all.

We'd particularly like to invite your views on:


- The overall project
