Lightsource bp is developing a new solar and energy storage project on land in the north of the Isle of Anglesey.

Prosiect Maen Hir could generate 360 megawatts (MW) of electricity – enough clean energy to power around 140,000 homes and avoid more than 71,000 tonnes of CO₂ every year.

You are invited to take part in our consultation running from 02 October to 15 November 2024. This formal stage of consultation is being carried out in line with the requirements of the Planning Act 2008.

We will review our proposals in light of the views and comments received in response to this consultation, along with the findings from our ongoing environmental assessment so we can finalise and submit our application for development consent to the Planning Inspectorate (PINS).
